DUTIES:

The position is one of eight (8) classifications which report directly to the Superintendent of Public Works. Under the general supervision of the Superintendent of Public Works, the Welder/Mechanic is responsible for the fabrication, repair and maintenance of Town equipment and/or works equipment. The incumbent is also responsible for the provision of repairs and standard maintenance procedures to ensure that all equipment is operational. The position is required to operate Town equipment (front end loader) on an as needed basis and receives job direction for the Lead Hand in the absence of the Superintendent.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Successful completion of high school, supplemented by post-secondary education in welding and heavy equipment repair. An equivalent combination of experience and education may also be considered;
- Minimum of five (5) years experience in welding and mechanical repair with responsibility for similar duties;
- Demonstrated ability to deal with the public with tact and diplomacy;
- Demonstrate a high level of organizational and problem solving skills is required
- Position requires driver's licence classification in 5 & 8
